

Annual "News from the Lobby"

Now that the 2013 elections are in the rear view mirror, we can look straight ahead into a lame duck legislative session that may either be blissfully quiet or harrowingly dangerous. While it is no surprise that Governor Christie was re-elected with a 22 point shellacking of State Senator Barbara Buono, there were precious few changes in the legislative arena. In the State Senate, all incumbents from both sides of the aisle were re-elected and in the General Assembly, the Republicans picked up 1 seat. Senator Steve Sweeney (D-Gloucester) was re-elected Senate President and Assemblyman Vincent Prieto (D-Hudson) was elected as Speaker. The NJLBA has forged excellent relationships with both Senate President Sweeney and with Speaker-Elect Prieto and we look forward to working with them to continue making New Jersey a better place to live, to work and to raise a family.

The NJLBA - and the hospitality sector in general - continues to face difficult challenges. The number of inactive licenses has soared to over 1400 and the level of retailer credit default has risen to over 30% - the highest level in decades. Still mired in near recession, the New Jersey hospitality sector continues to take it on the chin. Despite these dire economic conditions, there are many pieces of very negative legislation that threaten to further damage our industry. Now - more than ever - the NJLBA needs to mobilize both in terms of opposing bad legislation and by way of aggressively recruiting new members to join the army of industry opposition to, among a host of others, the following pieces of legislation:

S2009/A1325 - (Senator Beach/Assemblyman Greenwald) - Removes the Two License Limitation on ownership of package store licenses; allows big box retailers like Costco and

Walmart to dominate New Jersey marketplace.

A3991 - (Assemblyman John Burzichelli) - Allows towns across New Jersey to issue as many new retail consumption and distribution licenses as they see fit - as long as the licenses are located in what the bill refers to as "smart growth zones." The language will encourage the liberal issuance of new licenses resulting in a massive dilution in the value, as well as accelerated bankruptcies, of existing licensed businesses throughout New Jersey.

A1525 - (Assemblyman John Burzichelli) - Establishes a new class of plenary retail consumption license that permits the sales of wine and beer for consumption on the licensed premises. The fee for the restricted restaurant license is to be fixed by the municipality in which the licensed premises are situated at 75% of the fee for a plenary retail consumption license. This means that, in a typical town where the license renewal fee is \$2000 annually, a purchaser of this proposed license would pay \$1500 and become an alcoholic beverage licensed restaurant. This bill contains no limit on the amount of new licenses to be issued.

There are many more dangerous pieces of legislation pending in the Legislature. We, as an industry, must continue to rise and meet these challenges. Our livelihoods and families depend on it. If and when you get the call that a legislative committee is scheduled to hold a hearing on a bill, immediately respond to the call to action. Your calls to colleagues, to legislators and your testimony in Trenton are all critical elements in the process.

From my family to yours, I wish a happy, healthy and successful holiday season to all.

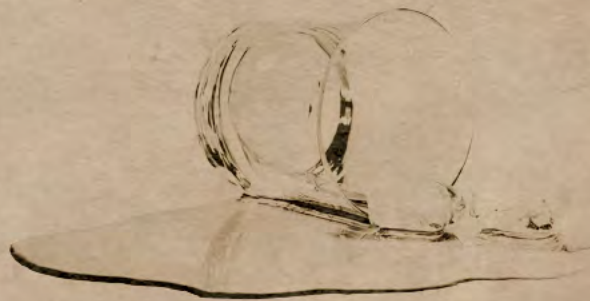

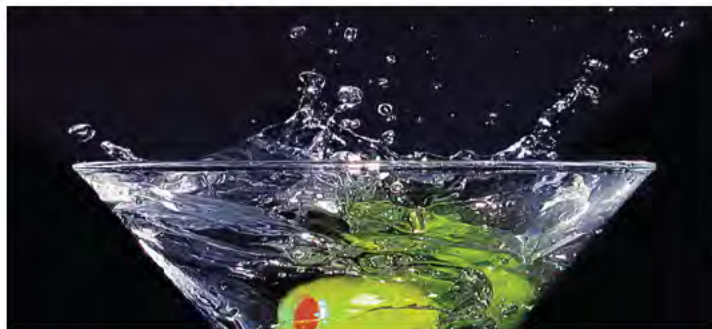

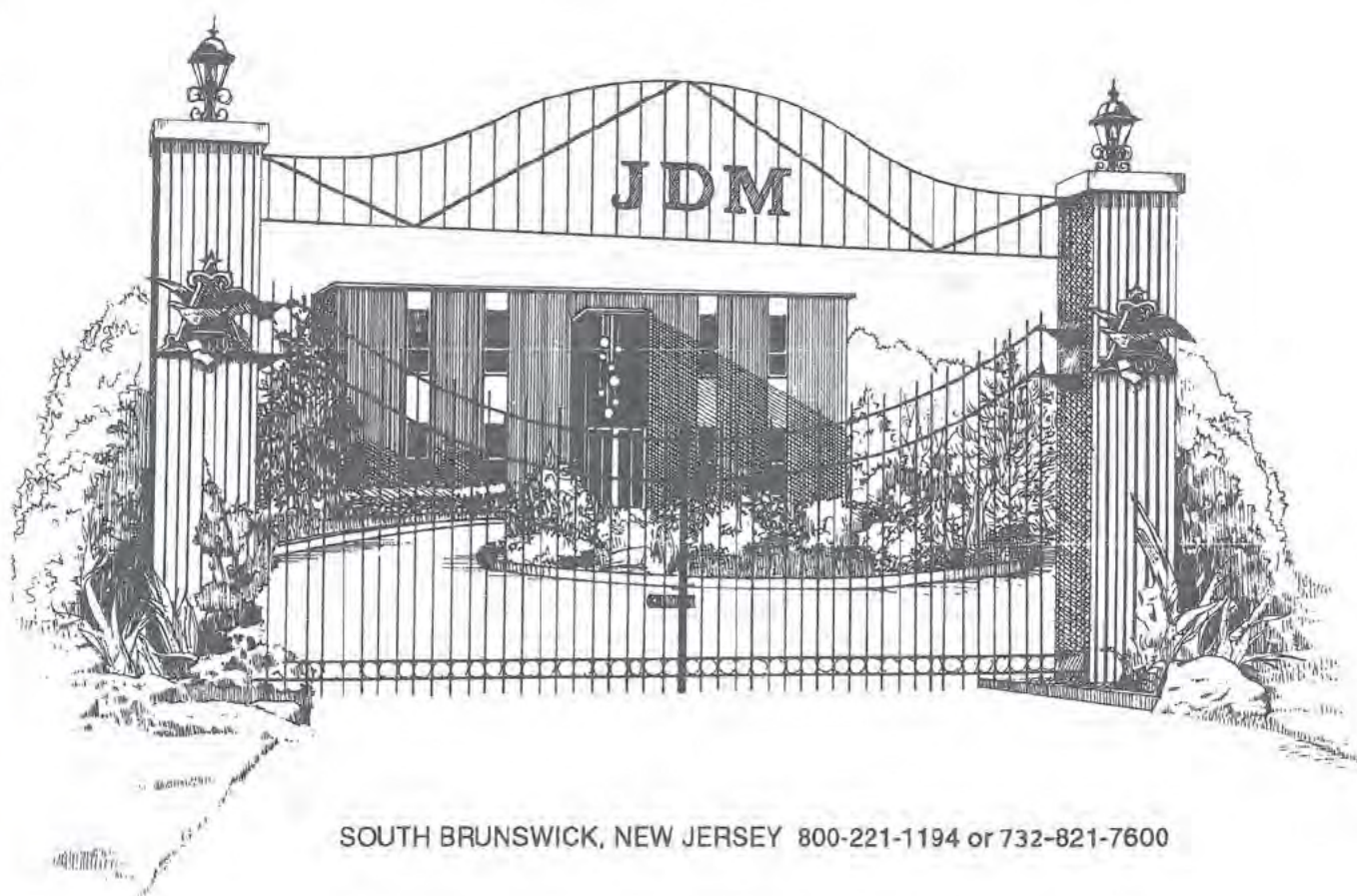
